

Recruiting Fraud

All job seekers need to be aware of fraudulent recruiting scams and communications that do not come from QuarterNorth Energy.

These recruiting scams can appear as fraudulent job postings on legitimate job sites. Cybercriminals often use convincing company logos, wording, and phony websites that appear to be those of the real company. In some cases, these perpetrators may also seek money for services they will not render.

During the recruiting process, QuarterNorth Energy will never ask job applicants to provide non-work-related personal information like social security numbers, financial information such as bank accounts or credit card numbers, date of birth, or marital status in any of our communications (phone, email, online or fax). QuarterNorth Energy never asks for fees from either potential applicants or contractors. Emails that do not end in @qnenergy.com are not from QuarterNorth Energy.
